

BOATING

Boating can be fun but is inherently dangerous. For your protection and safety New York State requires a personal flotation device be worn by each person in the boat. It is also a good idea to take an extra paddle. Although it is allowable by law if you have a light aboard, we do not recommend boating at night. Most areas of the lake are suitable for boating with most of the motor boat traffic in West Bay and the least in North Bay. If you are planning a trip to the marsh, please be aware that in late afternoon the wind generally picks up making the return trip more difficult.

No boats are permitted in the roped off swimming areas.

After reading both sides of this brochure, please sign the tear-off section provided and return it to us. Only guests who have received and read this brochure may use the beach or rent a boat.

RENTAL AGREEMENT

- I acknowledge and appreciate the inherent danger in boating and in the possession and use of the boat and other related equipment assigned to me. I hereby voluntarily expose myself and everyone in my party to that danger and assume all risk of injury and damage to property.
- I waive The Waldheim, Inc., its agents, and its employees of all liability for negligence relating to the boat and equipment assigned to me. I have inspected all equipment and by acceptance and use have found them to be in good and safe condition.
- I hereby hold The Waldheim, Inc., its agents and employees harmless from any and all expenses, claims, suits, demands, costs, and fees relating to any act or omission resulting in personal injury or property damage.
- I acknowledge that no other representations have been made by or on behalf of The Waldheim, Inc., and I rely on none.

SWIMMING

The swimming facilities at The Waldheim are not supervised by a lifeguard or other responsible person. In place of on-site supervision, this facility has established a series of safeguards to be followed by all guests.

We are required to notify you of these rules, to ensure that water rescue equipment is at the beach and that the swimming area is maintained in a sanitary manner. In the interest of your

safety and that of your guests, we require you to follow these rules.

Please read the safety rules located at the beach and in this brochure. If you have any questions, we will be happy to discuss them with you.

- ② NEVER SWIM ALONE. A minimum of two adults 18 years of age or older, must be present whenever the beach is in use.
- THERE IS NO SUBSTITUTE FOR ADEQUATE SUPERVISION. Children under 16 years of age must be accompanied to the beach by a parent or guardian with at least one adult remaining on shore.

IN AN EMERGENCY, NOTIFY THE OFFICE FOR HELP IMMEDIATELY. That is also the location of the nearest telephone and 911 is the emergency number.

- ⑦ Resuscitation masks and disposable gloves are available at the office.
- ⑦ Only use the beach during posted hours.
- ⑦ Don't drink alcohol and swim.

Injuries can be prevented and safety is everyone's responsibility. If you notice any problems with the water quality or the absence of safety equipment, please notify us at once.

After you have read both sides of this brochure, please sign the tear-off section provided and return it to us. Only guests who have received and read this brochure may use the beach or rent boats.

I have read and understand the beach safety rules and the boating rental agreement. I understand there will be no lifeguard on duty at the beach and understand the inherent risk of boating. I will abide by the rules listed in this brochure and those listed at the beach.
